

How to measure for your blinds:

Please always measure to the nearest 5mm increment

Example:

1000mm, 1255mm, 1485mm, 1600mm, 1845mm, 2235mm etc

There are two ways to install/measure you blind:

- Inside reveal (inside the window)
- Outside reveal (outside window overlapping the window) we recommend to add 100mm extra on your inside reveal, this means that your blind will overlap 50mm on each side width and height.

Vision Blinds

Inside reveal measurement:

- Measure the width first in millimeters,
- Measure the top section as you see in image,
- Deduct 10mm off the width (we deduct 10mm off the width so the Vision Blind casette can fit perfectly and does not touch the side walls)
- Measure the height,
- Measure the middle part of the window
- Deduct 10mm off the height (we deduct 10mm off the height so the material does not touch the window sil)
- Submit the sizes on the Order Page

Outside reveal measurement:

- Take the inside measurement size and add 100mm to width and height

Example:

Inside measurement: 1465 x 1240 Outside measurement: 1575 x 1350 width
